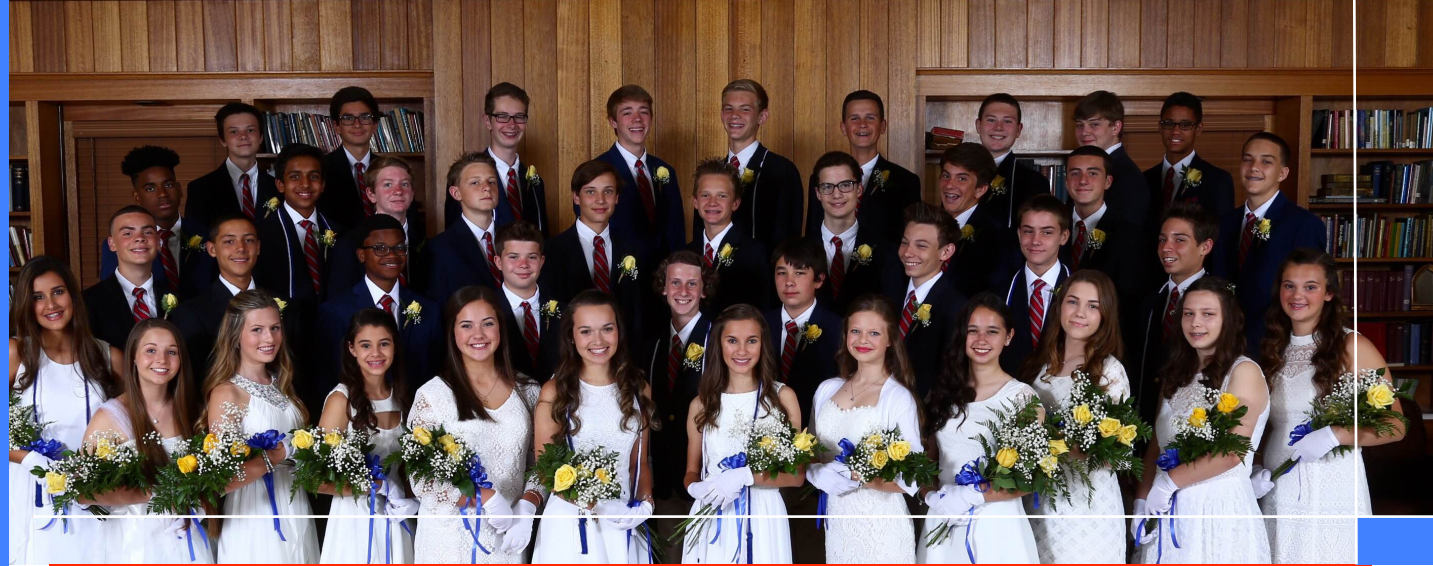


# Securing Our Future.
